## Piping Events

Event	Grade	Requirement	Comments
1	D	Two parts of a Slow Air.	
2	D	Two parts of a 2/4 March.	
3	C	Four parts of a 2/4 March.	The tune must be a four-parted tune.
4	C	Two parts of a Strathspey and two parts of a Reel.	
5	C	Piobaireachd Urlar and next variation.	If the tune has a singling and doubling variation only the singling is to be played.
6	B	At least four parts of a March, at least four parts of a Strathspey and at least four parts of a Reel.	Competitors to submit two sets to the judge. The judge will select the set to be played.
7	B	At least four parts of a Hornpipe and at least four parts of a Jig.	Competitors to submit two sets to the judge. The judge will select the set to be played.
8	B	Piobaireachd.	One tune submitted with entry. Must include a crunluath variation.
9	A	At least four parts of a March, at least four parts of a Strathspey and at least four parts of a Reel.	Competitors to submit two marches, two strathspeys and two reels to the judge. The judge will select either march to be played with either strathspey, and either reel.
10	A	At least four parts of a Hornpipe and at least four parts of a Jig.	Competitors to submit two hornpipes and two jigs to the judge. The judge will select either hornpipe to be played with either jig.
11	A	Piobaireachd.	Three tunes to be submitted with entry. Both to have a crunluath variation.

## Snare Drumming Events

Event	Grade	Requirement
12	D	Two parts of a Simple Time March.
13	C	Four parts of a 2/4 March, into two parts each of Strathspey and Reel.
14	B	March, Strathspey & Reel each four parts or more.
15	B	Hornpipe and Jig each four parts.
16	A	March, Strathspey & Reel each four parts or more.
17	A	Hornpipe and Jig each four parts.

## Tenor Drumming Events

Event	Grade	Requirement
18	D	Two parts of a Simple Time March.
19	C	Four parts of a 2/4 March, into two parts each of Strathspey and Reel.
20	B	March, Strathspey & Reel each four parts or more
21	A	March, Strathspey & Reel each four parts or more.

22	D	Two parts of a Simple Time March into two parts of 6/8 March
23	C	Four parts of a 2/4 March, into two parts each of Strathspey and Reel
24	B	March Strathspey & Reel each four parts or more.
25	A	March, Strathspey & Reel each four parts or more.

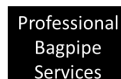

## General Conditions of Entry

1. The contest will be run in accordance with the A.P.B.A. Inc. rules currently in force.
2. All competitors compete at their own risk.
3. The organising committee reserves the right to reject any entry, curtail, postpone or cancel any event or otherwise deal with the program as they deem necessary.
4. Entries close Friday 23 September 2016.
5. If a competitor fails to attend they will not be refunded the entry fee.
6. Competitors may only enter in their registered grade.
7. There must be two competitors in an event otherwise it will not proceed.
8. If there are only two entries then 1<sup>st</sup> prize only will be awarded. If there are only three entries then 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prizes only will be awarded. If there are four or more entries 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes will be awarded.
9. If heats are required the first three place-getters in each heat will advance to the final.
10. Champion piper and drummer events will be awarded five points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, three points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place and one point for 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
11. The champion A Grade Piper must enter and play in the A Grade Piobaireachd event.
12. In the event of a tie in the D Grade piping or snare drumming championships the 2/4 March placing will be used to decide the winner.
13. In the event of a tie in the C piping or snare drumming championship, the March event will decide the winner
14. In the event of a tie in B Grade piping or snare drumming championships the March, Strathspey and Reel placing will be used to decide the winner.
15. In the event of a tie in the A Grade piping championships the Piobaireachd placing will be used to decide the winner.
16. In the event of a tie in A Grade snare drumming championships the March, Strathspey and Reel placing will be used to decide the winner.
